

NEW PASSPORT WITH CHANGE OF NAME. December 2004

32 page passport £36 stg @ exchange rate (was .65 cent on 5.8.'04); is now **0.6815** as of 04.11.'04 = 52.82 Euro

(64 page passport is £43 stg = 63 Euro which is 10 euros more)

If therefore you want the Consul to apply for a passport on your behalf please enclose a postal order or personal cheque or cash amounting to **70.00 Euros** (for 32 pages) or (80 euro for 64 pages) made payable to Philippine Consulate Dublin. **Please No £ sterling payments to be made to Philippine Consulate Dublin. I can not accept sterling payments.** Send to my home address at 8 Georgian Village, Castleknock, Dublin 15. Alternatively apply in person at 36 Parnel Square Dublin 1 any Wednesday or Saturday from 12 noon to 5pm.

The following is a sample letter to accompany the application if you decide to send it yourself, instead of giving it to the Consul to send. (You would be strongly advised to send it by Courier because since 27th Oct 2004 the registered mail system appears to have broken down, and it's taking over 20 days for it to get to London. The Royal Mail in London won't even admit that there is a problem; that's according to the Irish GPO Tracing Service at 1850 575 859)

Find enclosed the following requirements for replacement passport for the above mentioned Filipina:-

1. Current passport No. issued in..... on
2. One copy of completed application form.
3. **Four identical standard size photos less than 6 months old. (light background with no head gear)**
4. Completed registration form for Filipinos.
5. Self addressed envelope without stamps. An extra £4.50 is enclosed with draft to cover your return post of the old and new passport.
6. Sterling draft made payable to Philippine Embassy as follows
£36.00 stg Passport fee.
4.50 Your registered rtn post
£40.50 stg bank or post office draft **payable to Philippine Embassy London.**

In addition the applicant wishes her new name to appear in her passport as her new name as follows:-

Print your new name in full:

If you were married in the Philippines enclose only the following extra requirement:-

1. Three photocopies of Philippine marriage certificate + original.

If married outside the Philippines enclose the following requirements:-

1. Three photocopies of the ID pages of husbands passport authenticated by Honorary Consul.
2. Three report of marriage forms completed; with photos of husband and wife on each report and photos signed on front.
3. Three copies of marriage certificate plus original.
4. 26.50 euros is the cost of registering a marriage at the London Embassy (£18 stg)
5. If the report of marriage is one year late enclose an extra 26.5 euros for the fine. (£18).

P.S. original marriage certificates do not have to be forwarded to London Embassy if shown to the Philippine consul in Dublin.
