**INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR 32 OR 64 PAGE PASSPORTS Nov 4th 2004**

32 page passport £36 stg @ exchange rate (was .65 cent on 5.8.'04); is now **0.6815** as of 04.11.'04 = 52.82 Euro  
(64 page passport is £43 stg = 63 Euro which is 10 euros more)

If therefore you want the Consul to apply for a passport on your behalf please enclose a postal order or personal cheque or cash amounting to **70.00 Euros** (for 32 pages) or (80 euro for 64 pages) made payable to Philippine Consulate Dublin. **Please No £ sterling** payments to be made to Philippine Consulate Dublin. I can not accept sterling payments. Send to my home address at 8 Georgian Village, Castleknock, Dublin 15. Alternatively apply in person at 36 Parnell Square Dublin 1 any Wednesday or Saturday from 12 noon to 5pm.

**The following is a sample letter to accompany the application if you decide to send it yourself, instead of giving it to the Consul to send.**

(You would be strongly advised to send it by Courier because since 27<sup>th</sup> Oct 2004 the registered mail system appears to have broken down, and it's taking over 20 days for it to get to London. The Royal Mail in London won't even admit that there is a problem; that's according to the Irish GPO Tracing Service at 1850 575 859)

Find enclosed the following requirements for replacement passport for the above mentioned Filipina:-

1. Current passport No. .... issued in..... on .....
2. One copy of completed application form.
3. **Four identical standard size photos less than 6 months old. (light background with no head gear)**
4. Completed registration form for Filipinos.
5. Self addressed envelope without stamps. An extra £4.50 is enclosed with draft to cover your return post of the old and new passport.
6. Sterling draft made payable to Philippine Embassy as follows  
£36.00 stg ..... Passport fee.  
4.50 ..... Your registered rtn post  
£40.50 stg bank or post office draft **payable to Philippine Embassy London.**

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR MINOR APPLYING FOR REGISTRATION OF BIRTH AND PASSPORT**

1. Completed passport application form, Fee is **70.00 euro** plus **26.50** for registration of birth plus **26.50** if over one year late.
2. Original and three (3) clear photocopies of Birth Certificate ( Showing both parent's names )
3. Completed Report of Birth Form in triplicate ( Available from the Consul )
4. Three (3) photocopies of parent's valid Philippine passport or Naturalisation paper if former Filipino.  
(on 25.8.2003 the DFA in Manila issued an instruction that all applications for late registration of Reports of Birth and Marriage shall be assessed a consular fee of \$25 US (i.e. £18 = 26.50 euros @ exchange rate of .6815 as of 4.11.2004).
